Benson, AZ

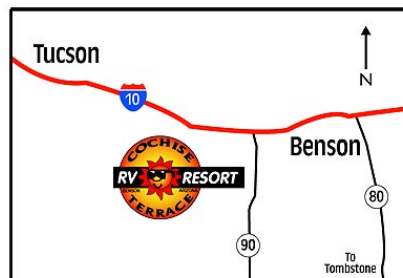

Visit the historic western towns of Tombstone,  
Benson, Wilcox, Old Bisbee, Fort Huachuca and more.

Located just 1 mile off I10, (exit 302) in Benson, AZ, Cochise Terrace RV park is just 7 miles from Kartchner caverns, 15 minutes from historic Gammon's Gulch, 30 minutes from Tombstone, 20 minutes from the Chochise Stronghold in the Dragoon Mts., and 50 minutes from Bisbee. For history buffs, Historic Fort Huachuca in Sierra Vista, famous for the Buffalo soldiers and Gen. Black Jack Pershing's infamous quest for Pancho Villa, is just a 30 minutes drive. For shopping and Casinos, Tucson is only 40 minutes away.

All sites in Cochise Terrace RV park are 50/30A, have full hook ups, are spotless, and level. The two clubhouses will be able to host 3 different events simultaneously plus a huge outdoor covered patio. Vendors will have pull through sites next to the main clubhouse.

Because of the tremendous amount of nearby attractions, this rally will have two free days. The flea market, open house, games and hands on demos will be during the two free days. Bring your treasures!!



Temperatures for this time of year are 80's during the day, 60's—70's in the evenings. Very pleasant for sleeping. Expect humidity in the 10 -20% range and gentle breezes.

Fuel prices are .20—.25 cents lower than CA. There is an easy access major fuel stop just 1 mile from the park. The area has several RV repair facilities within a 45 minute drive, and 2 major RV supply businesses less than 25 miles away.

A large fire ring with seating, complete with Mesquite firewood is available and a kegger will be hosted on one of the free nights next to the fire ring. Be prepared to tell your favorite jokes.

The park will permit on-site repairs. On site coach washing is permitted with a \$5 fee for water usage. Office contact is required.

The park has a huge, heated pool, with a small array of exercise machines, next to the GMC parking sites, large Laundromat, and showers. Additionally, there is a huge, covered outdoor patio with picnic tables for outdoor events.

**NOTICE TO VENDORS:** In the rare event of rain, the large clubhouse across from vendors row can be utilized. Plenty of room and tables. Displays will not have to be taken down for meals or other events.
