Cochise Terrace RV Park

Cochise Terrace RV park is new, and modern. The park is spotless, all sites have 30 and 50 amp hookups. All sites are level and our area will be close to the club-houses, pool, spa, and outside exercise equipment. The park also has a separate fire ring for gatherings plus the added benefit of seating. All GMCs will be parked together, vendors will have separate parking in the GMC group area. Hands on demonstrations are permissible and encouraged. Journey repairs are also permitted. Coach washing will have a \$5 water fee added to your space rental.

Weather

The weather this time of year is quite pleasant. Upper 70's, lower 80's during the day accompanied by gentle breezes, 60's at night. Expect 10–15% humidity, no rain.

Sightseeing

Southeastern AZ is loaded with areas to see. In addition to being one of the premier riparian areas in the US, there are ghost towns, mining towns, historic Fort Huachuca, Cochise Stronghold, Tombstone city, the Pima Air museum and more. All within a short distance from the rally park.

- This rally will have two free days because there is so much to see and do. Open coach will fall on both of these days with two separate groups.
- The flea market will be a two day, ongoing event so bring your treasures.
- Directions: Take I-10 30 miles east of Tucson to exit 320 (Hwy 90). Turn South. The park entrance is one mile from the interstate.
